Arranging the mobility

Housing	<p>Student dormitories /two 4-storey buildings/ are situated on the university campus. They offer three-bed rooms with bathrooms (linen and blankets are not provided) and apartments for 4 persons (2 separate rooms with 2 bathrooms). The students have access to a kitchen and laundry (on the floor). A monthly price is 250.00 BG leva (equal to 125 EUR - exchange rate EUR/BG is 1.945).</p> <p>The students have to pay an entry tax on the registration to the dormitory, which is 7.5 € per semester and 15 € per academic year.</p> <p>The electricity costs are included in the price to a certain limit. Additional consumption has to be paid. It is approx. 20.00 € per month, depending on the season.</p> <p>Internet connection costs an additional 15.00 € per month.</p> <p>A deposit of 250.00 BG leva (125 EUR) is required for your registration to the dormitory. The deposit is refundable at the end of the stay. Registration to the dormitory is from Monday to Friday between 8 am – 15,30 pm</p>
