Arranging the mobility

Student dormitories /two 4-storey buildings/ are situated on the university campus (google maps - <u>https://shorturl.at/KCt21</u>). They offer three-bed rooms with bathrooms (linen and blankets are not provided) and apartments for 4 persons (2 separate rooms with 2 bathrooms). The students have access to a kitchen and laundry (on the floor).

A monthly price is 250.00 BG leva (equal to 125 EUR - exchange rate EUR/BG is 1.945).

Housing The students have to pay an entry tax on the registration to the dormitory, which is $7.5 \in$ per semester and $15 \in$ per academic year.

The electricity costs are included in the price to a certain limit. Additional consumption has to be paid. It is approx. $20.00 \in$ per month, depending on the season.

Internet connection costs an additional 15.00 € per month.

A deposit of 250.00 BG leva (125 EUR) is required for your registration to the dormitory. The deposit is refundable at the end of the stay. Registration to the dormitory is from Monday to Friday between 8.00 AM – 15,30 PM

Application for student mobility

The application is an online application process in three steps:

1. Nomination - incoming Erasmus+ students should be nominated by their home university. Nomination form

2. Application

Once their nomination is received we will send email with link to application form. The students should prepare the following documents, scan them and upload to the application form:

- ID/Passport copy (jpg)
- Passport photo (jpg)
- Transcript of records (pdf)

Students should have European Health insurance card.

3. Online Learning agreement

The incoming students should create an Online Learning agreement for study (<u>https://www.learning-agreement...</u>) using our <u>OLA Guide</u>.

<u>Learning agreement for traineeship</u> is still on paper. Students should download it and after being filled and signed by the Erasmus+ coordinator at home university, the students should upload it (scanned, as pdf file) to the application form.
