SUBMISSION RULES: articles have not previously been published in any collection, journal or books; it is required to present only the main results of personal research. The responsibility of the information provided in the materials belongs to the author or the authors.

The file should be named with the name of the author of the article. If there are several authors, then you should send the surname of the first author (example: Ibragimov). The articles will be accepted for publishing both in electronic and printed form in the congress materials.

ARTICLES SHOULD BE PREPARED AS FOLLOWS: the text should be typed in Microsoft Word in A4 format; Times New Roman, 12 pt., interval 1, line spacing 1.25 cm; no spaces should be omitted; line-by-line translation of the word is not allowed.

The article must have max.10 pages; **MAIN** titles should be written in **CAPITAL** letters and bold. Initials and surnames must be indicated after the line skipping. In the next line should be written the full name of the enterprise or organisation to which the participant belongs. The following line should be containing an E-Mail or postal address to contact the participant or participants. These should be written in the centre of the format. The text should be added after a line is omitted.

PUBLICATION

In the moment your article is accepted you will get a written confirmation and further information regarding the program of the congress. The accepted articles will be published in the Journal of scientific works of ADAU with an International Standard Serial Number (ISSN). No additional fee is required for this.
