

2023 Chinese Government Scholarship-High-level Graduate Students Program, Nanjing Agricultural University

I. Program Description

In 2023, Chinese Government Scholarship is expected to support outstanding international students who wish to enrol into full-time graduate-level degree Programs at Nanjing Agricultural University (hereinafter referred to as NAU) commencing in Academic Year 2023-2024. The successful applicants will be offered the Chinese Government Scholarship covering the duration of the degree programs.

II. Program Type

1) Bilateral Program (Type A)

Bilateral Program includes a full or partial scholarship established by MOE in accordance with educational exchange agreements or consensus between Chinese government and governments of other countries, institutions, universities or international organizations. NAU doesn't accept this type of application. Instead, a pre-admission will be provided for the qualified candidate to facilitate the application. IV. Funding Policy

- 1) **Tuition Waiver**
- 2) **Accommodation:** Free dormitory (standard room) for on-campus students. Accommodation subsidy for off-campus students: CNY 700 per month for Master students and CNY 1,000 per month for PhD students.
- 3) **Monthly Stipend:** CNY 3,000 per month for Master students; CNY 3,500 per month for Doctoral students.
- 4) **Comprehensive medical insurance:** Please visit <http://www.csc.edu.cn/studyinchina> or <http://www.campuschina.org> and refer to Comprehensive Insurance & Protection Scheme for Foreigners Staying in China for insurance policy.
- 5) **International travel expenses are borne by the students themselves.**

Note:

- 1) Students registered before 15th (inclusive) of the month will be entitled to the whole monthly stipend. Those who register after 15th will receive half of the monthly stipend of September. Students who fail to register after the deadline will be automatically disqualified from Chinese Government Scholarship.
- 2) Students should strictly abide by the regulations of the University. For students who leave China during the school holidays, the monthly stipend will be paid normally. For students who

asks for leave for more than 15 days in one month or for more than 15 consecutive days for personal reasons in addition to the school holidays, the monthly stipend will be deducted accordingly.

V. Application Eligibility

- 1) The applicant must be a citizen of a country other than the People's Republic of China, and must hold a valid ID certificate.
- 2) The applicant must apply from abroad, or the applicant is an outstanding graduate from a Chinese university, and has been recommended by his/her university.
- 3) The applicant for a Master's program must be a bachelor's degree holder or equivalent of relating majors. The applicant for a PhD program must be a master's degree holder or equivalent of relating majors.
- 4) The applicant must have excellent academic performance, and meets the requirements of the applied major.
- 5) The applicant must be in good physical and mental health. The applicant must be no more than 35 when applying for a Master's program. The applicant must be no more than 40 when applying for a PhD program.
- 6) Language requirement
 - Chinese-taught Programs: It is mandatory to acquire a valid certificate of HSK Level 5(or above). Those who have used Chinese as the language of instruction to obtain a Chinese university degree do not need to provide proof of Chinese proficiency.
 - English-taught Programs:
Applicants from English-speaking countries are exempted from providing proof of English proficiency (or);
Certificate of IELTS ≥ 6 or TOFEL ≥ 80 (TOFEL Mybest Scores is accepted, university DI code:C702, TOFEL Essentials are accepted.) (or);
If the applicant cannot provide certificate of standardized English test, he/she should provide relevant proof of English teaching in the previous stage of degree study.
- 7) The applicant has submitted a complete set of materials.
- 8) The applicant has not been granted scholarships from other Scholarship Committees for the 2023/24 academic year.

(8) Acceptance Letter from a NAU Supervisor	<p>For supervisor list please refer to Attachment 6, and for acceptance form please refer to Attachment 7;</p> <p>1) The acceptance letter must be signed and approved by the master/doctoral supervisor of the discipline, otherwise it will be invalid.</p>
(9) Photocopy of the Foreigner Physical Examination Form (the original copy shall be kept by the applicant.)	<p>See Attachment 8;</p> <p>1) The form is designed by the Chinese quarantine authority and can be obtained from the dispatching authority, and should be completed in English;</p> <p>2) The physical examinations must cover all the items listed in the Foreigner Physical Examination Form.</p> <p>3) Please select the appropriate time to take a physical examination as the result is valid for only 6 months.</p> <p>4) Incomplete records or those without the signature of the attending physician, the official stamp of the hospital, or a sealed photograph of the applicants are invalid.</p>
(10) Copy of Valid Passport and Relevant Residence Documents	<p>1) Copy of valid passport and relevant residence documents. Note: If the validity of the applicant's current passport does not meet the requirement (meaning the passport expires before September 2023), please apply for a new passport before submitting the application.</p> <p>2) Applicants under the age of 18 should submit the valid documents of their legal guardians in China;</p>
(11) Copy of Valid Language Certificate	<p>1) Copy of valid language certificate or proof.</p>
(12) Non-criminal Record Report	<p>1) The applicant shall submit a valid certificate of Non-Criminal Record issued by the local public security authority, usually issued within 6 months prior to the submission date of the application.</p>
(13) Others	<p>1) Passport size personal ID photo;</p> <p>2) Publication (no need to submit for the fourth author and above);</p> <p>3) Overseas research experience proof.</p>

VII. Application Procedure

Step 1. Find a suitable degree program.

Step 2. Find a relevant supervisor to provide provisional acceptance letter.

Step 3. Prepare application documents. *Please refer to V. Documents Required.

Step 4. Register and apply in Chinese Government Scholarship Information Management System for International Students: <http://www.campuschina.org>. (**Type: B; Age ncy No.: 10307**)

- Step 5.** Register and apply in NAU university application system <https://njau.at0086.cn/StuApplication/Login.aspx>.
- Step 6.** Pay the application fee: **CNY 500 or USD 80**. While transferring application fee to NAU's bank account, please indicate your name and passport number on bank note's remark area and send the receipt to admission@njau.edu.cn. **The application fee is NON-REFUNDABLE once remitted.**
