3. Transparency and presentation of the obtained results.

The dissertation is set out in an introduction, five sections and a conclusion spread over 141 pages, as well as a list of the literature used. The study is illustrated with 11 tables and 12 diagrams. 193 literary sources were used in the dissertation work.

4. Discussion of the results and used literature.

In the dissertation structured in this way, the topicality of the chosen topic is skillfully presented and argued. The main elements of the research are presented in an orderly logical framework already in the introduction. This approach enables the reader (reviewer) to quickly and easily gain an idea of the purpose, object, subject and tasks of the scientific research even before entering in depth into the research carried out by the doctoral student and his scientific supervisor. The doctoral student has also determined the limits of penetration in the study of the defined scientific problem, objectively arguing the main limitations in the process of his work. Every single scientific research is carried out within the framework of limitations - organizational, financial or normative. However,
